

# **The Panhandle Trail - Washington County**

## **Rules & Regulations**

---

**The Panhandle Trail is open daily from dawn to dusk.**

- › **Please respect the adjacent landowners; stay on the trail.**
- › **No motorized vehicles.**
- › **Wheelchairs and other powered mobility devices may be used by persons who are mobility impaired. Powered mobility devices must meet the following characteristics: not wider than “36” and cannot travel faster than 15 mph under its own power on a level surface.**
- › **Electronic (e-bikes) which are pedal devices with an electric-assist motor are permitted if they meet certain conditions: a power rating of less than 750 watts, weight under 100lbs, and have a top speed of not more than 15 mph.**
- › **Horseback riding is permitted. Please keep horses off of the improved trail surface.**
- › **Please keep to the right, pass on the left.**
- › **Give an audible signal when passing other trail users.**
- › **All pets must be kept on a short leash and under control.**
- › **Please remove all pet and horse waste from the trail and dispose of properly.**
- › **Please dispose of litter properly.**
- › **Discharging a firearm is prohibited on or near the trail.**
- › **Bicyclists and horseback riders are encouraged to wear a helmet.**
- › **Violators will be prosecuted.**
